HALDANE RESERVE REGENERATION

Hidden away in Lenah Valley is a patch of rivulet bush, which could use our community's attention. The Lenah Valley Community Association is looking to involve local people and others in a project with City of Hobart Council to find a way forward to care for this land.

A proposed aim of the project is to promote the wellbeing of this currently, dog-free, native wildlife habitat.
